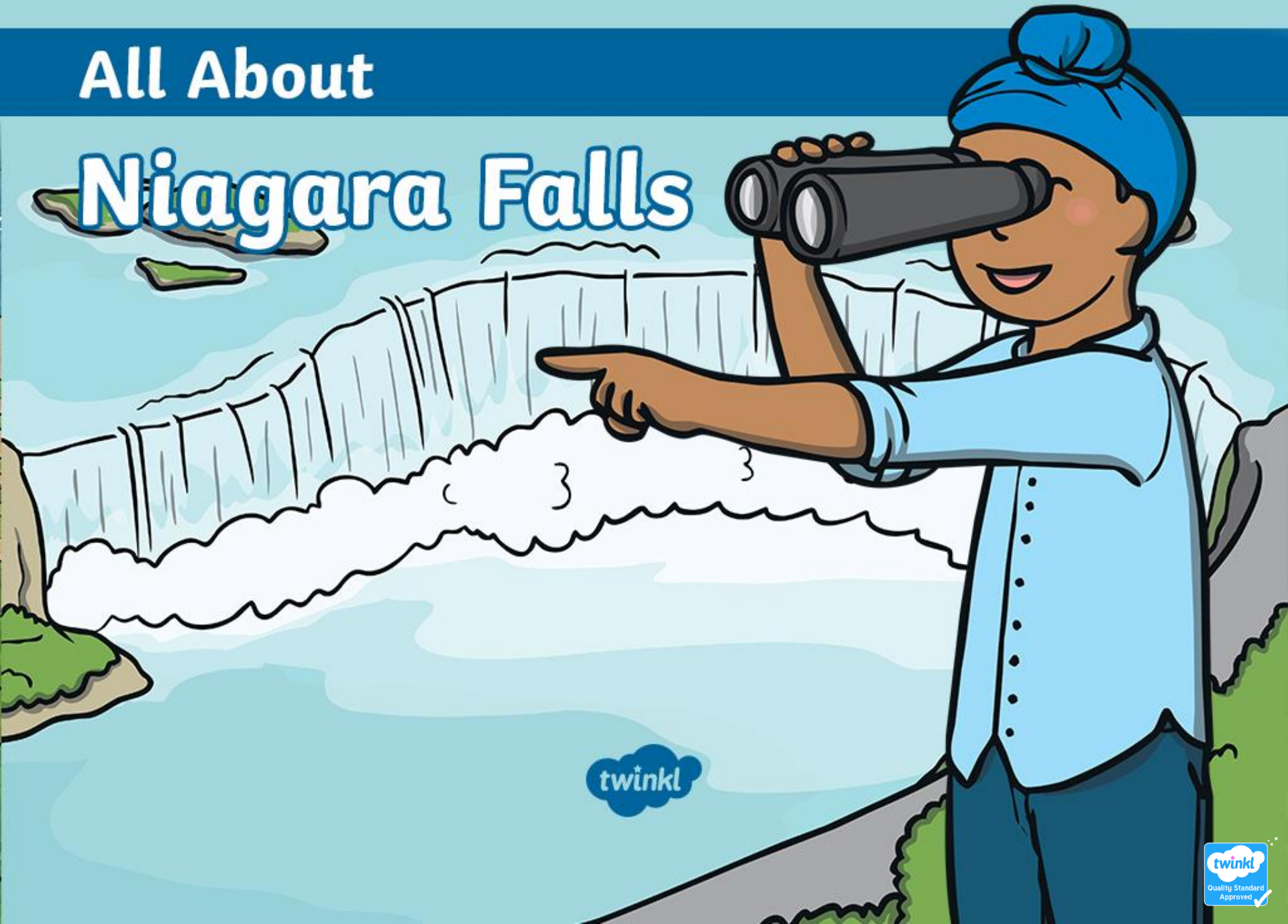

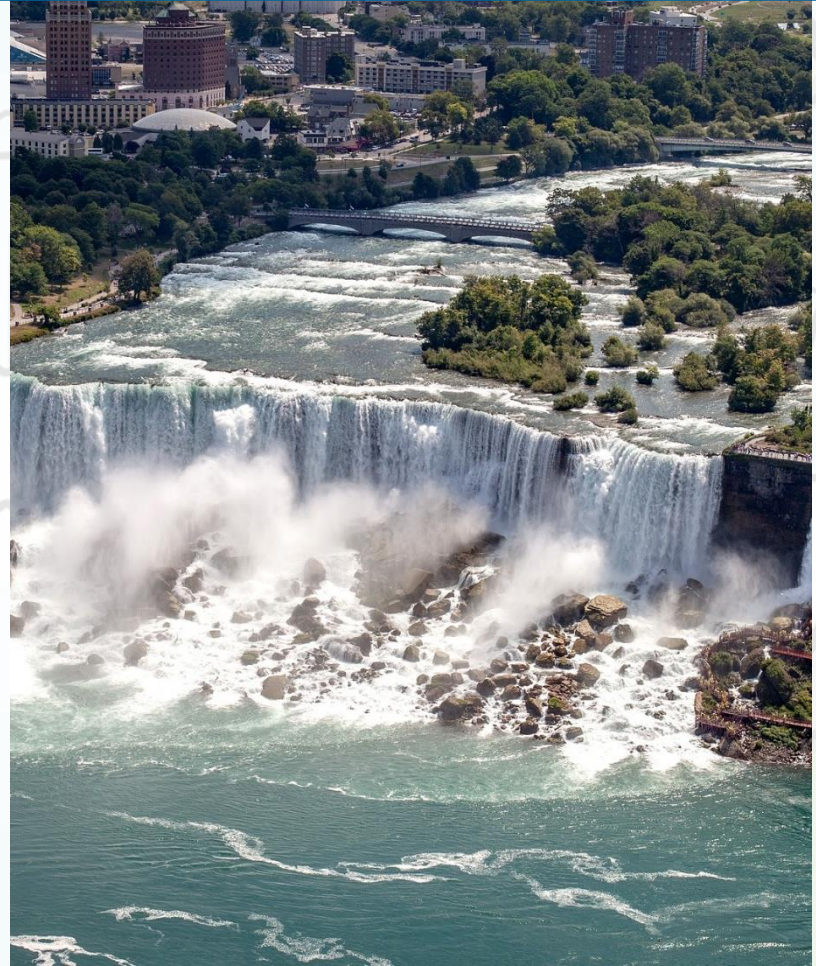
# Niagara Falls



# Wonderful Waterfalls

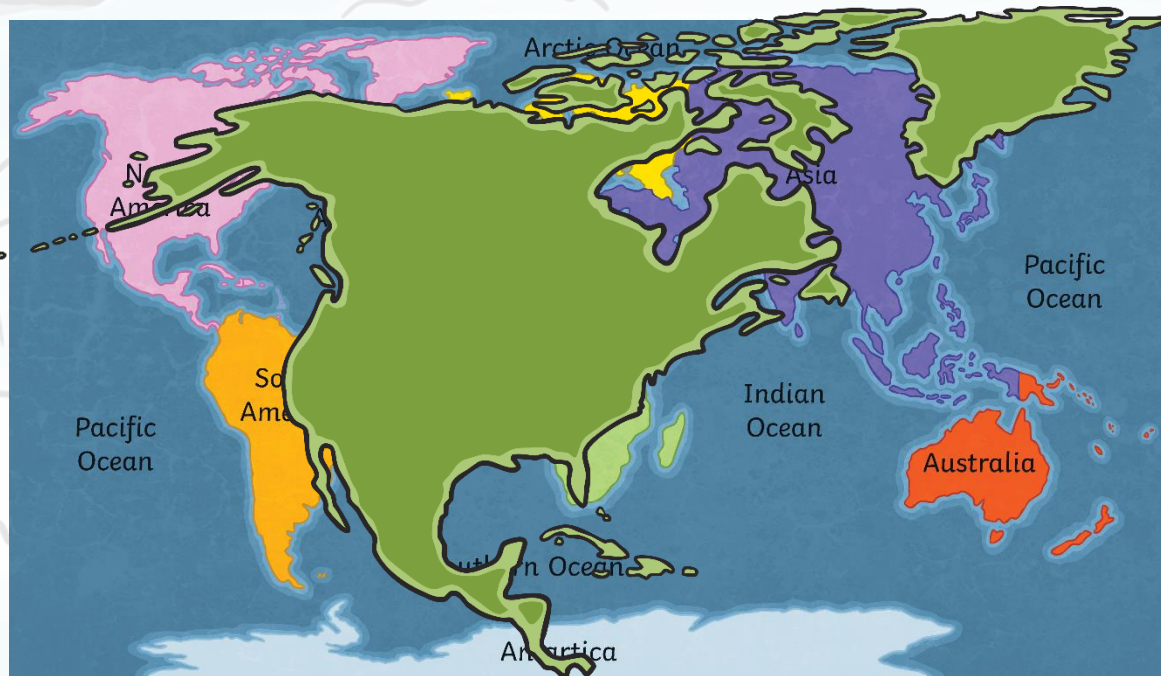
Niagara Falls is the name given to three waterfalls on the border between the USA and Canada.

A waterfall is when water falls over a rocky edge into a plunge pool below.

## Horseshoe Falls (Canadian Falls)

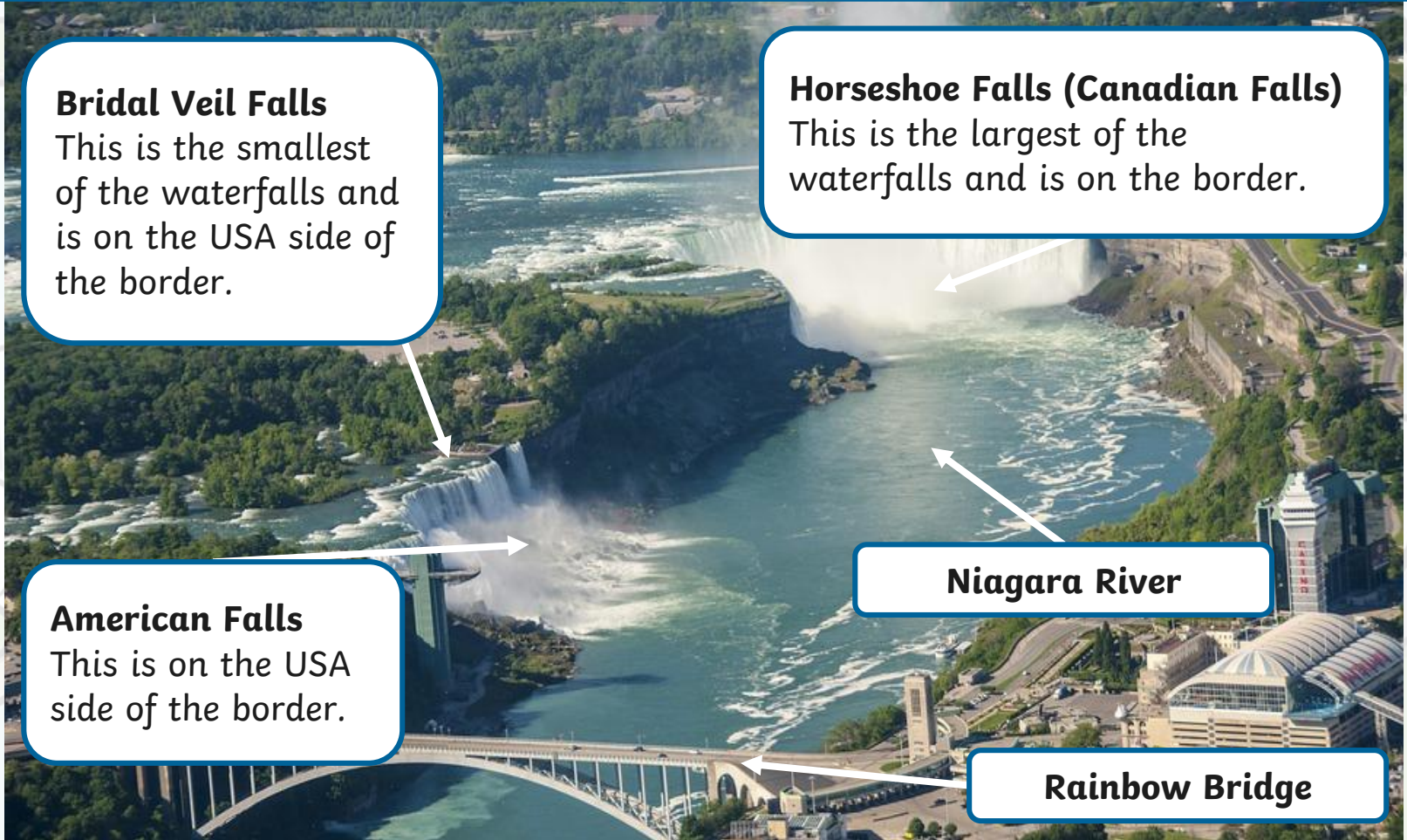
This is the largest of the waterfalls and is on the border.

Rainbow Bridge



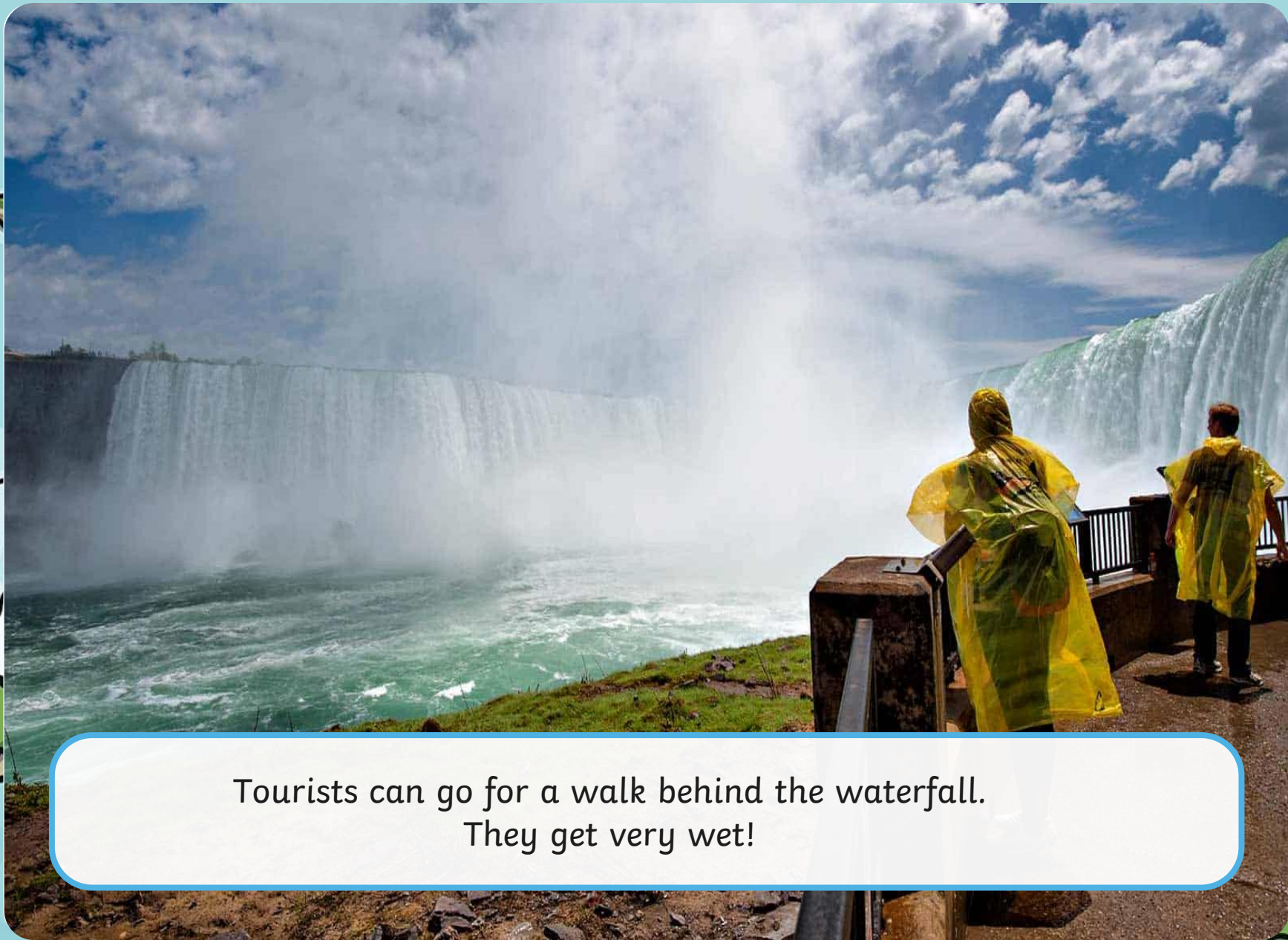
# Tourism
