SDP Target 1 – To ensure ‘quality first teaching’ is achieved throughout the school, especially in maths and writing, through consistent delivery approaches and adherence to the sequential learning provided by The Vine Curriculum and carefully selected schemes that are chosen and adapted to meet the needs of The Vine.

SDP Target 2 – To ensure that EYFS, KS1 and KS2 outcomes continue to be above national average. With the percentage reaching ‘Greater Depth’ in writing increasing by 5% compared to 2022 data (KS1 18% – KS2 16%) and the PPG v non gap closing in all areas.
