### Religious Education -compulsory

We have been learning about different communities including our school community, the church community and Cambourne. Can you draw a picture to show a community which you belong to (it can be one of the above or a different community). Write a sentence about why this community is special to you.

### Maths-compulsory

We have been learning about addition. Choose 2 numbers within 10, can you add them together to find the total. Use objects to help or counting on. Can you write the number sentence and show on a part-whole model? Choose 2 different numbers and repeat.

**Challenge:** Can you write a fact family for your number sentence ie;  $5+3=8$ ,  $3+5=8$ ,  $8=5+3$ ,  $8=3+5$

*Non-negotiable: Daily Practise of your number bonds*

### English-compulsory

We have been looking at Firework poems and thinking about all the exciting words to describe them. Can you write your own firework poem? Think about what they look and sound like.

*Non-negotiable Daily reading and complete 6 Book Challenge*

### Geography



#### Can you draw a map?

This term we have been looking at maps and thinking about the features that make it a good map. Your map could be of your house, your street, Cambourne, anywhere you wish.

### Science



This term we are looking at materials. Can you go on a hunt for objects in your house, draw a picture of it and tell us what material it is made from. Can you describe the material e.g., hard, soft, shiny

### Art



This half term we've been looking at the work of Hundertwasser and created our own model houses in the style of his work. Can you design your own happy house? Think carefully about the colours, shapes and patterns that you use.



### Computing

We have been learning about how to keep safe when using the internet. Can you design a poster to show what you should or shouldn't do when using the internet.

### Music



Listen to one of your favourite songs. How does it make you feel? What instruments can you hear? Is it a fast or slow rhythm? Can you tap along to the beat? Tell us about it in your home learning book.
