Religious Education - **compulsory**

Make a poster showing the similarities between Sikhism and Christianity.

Maths - **compulsory**

Complete the weekly Maths home learning task in your small red book. This will help you practise things we are learning in school.

Keep practising your 2-, 5- and 10-times tables too for our weekly Times Table Mountain challenge every Friday.

English - **compulsory**

Write a persuasive letter to an adult at home, convincing them to let you do something you really want to do!

Keep reading every day, including your book from the 6-book challenge. Complete any outstanding book reviews. Practise your weekly spellings too.

History

Make a fact file about one of the 'powerful voices' we have looked at this half-term.
E.g. David Attenborough, Rosa Parks, Malala Yousafzai, Great Thunberg, Ghandi.

Science

Draw and label a diagram to show how a seed germinates. Think about our learning on the different parts of a seed (including the actions we did): the seed coat, the food storage, the embryo (baby) and the leaves.

PE

Practise your ball skills, focussing on your aiming and controlling. Maybe you could teach your family one of the games we have been playing!

Art & Design

Create your own piece of artwork using natural materials, like we have done in school. Use whatever **fallen** treasures you can find if possible. Take a picture of your creation to show us what you made!

Languages

In Year 3, you will start to learn Spanish! Give yourself a head start by learning how to count from 0-10 in Spanish. You can practise by watching videos, singing along to Spanish songs, making posters or any other way.
