### Religious Education - **compulsory**

We have been looking at what Christians think God is like in our RE lessons. Read or watch the story of 'Moses and the Burning Bush' (in Exodus 3) and write what this shows us about what God is like. You could draw a comic strip or picture from the story to remind you of it.

### Maths - **compulsory**

Complete the weekly Maths home learning task in your new red book. This will help you practise things we are learning in school.

Keep practising your 2-, 5- and 10-times tables too for our weekly Times Table Mountain challenge every Friday.

### English - **compulsory**

Write a persuasive letter to children at The Vine to encourage them to scoot, cycle, walk or roller skate to school instead of driving.

What would be the benefits of coming to school this way?  
Keep reading every day and practising for your weekly spellings tests too!

### Geography

We have been learning about the British Isles in Geography: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. Can you label them on a map and its capital? Can you label some human and physical features too?

### Science & DT

We designed and made vegetable spring rolls in DT. Can you use this knowledge to design a healthy meal? It can be a drawing of a plate on a meal, a real-life healthy meal, a menu for a restaurant or any other way you choose.

### PSHCE

We have been learning about the 'Pants Rule' with the help of Pantosaurus: that privates are private. Can you design a poster with a funky pair of pants on to remind us of this? Look up the NSPCC Pants Rule if you need help.

### Art & Design

We have been looking at Flora and Fauna in Art this term. Create some of your own artwork based on this (minibeast in their habitats). You can do this with colouring pencils, paints, crayons, printing, or whatever else you have at home.

### Music & Oracy

Interview some friends or family about their favourite rock song. What is it called? Who sings it? Why do they like it? What is their favourite style of music?
