Religious Education –compulsory

Research and make a poster of the four callings of Methodism. Explain what the four callings are and draw an image to represent each of them.

Maths–compulsory

Calculate the addition and subtraction questions provided in your book.

Daily practise of times tables using Mathsframe times tables check.

English–compulsory

Write your own persuasive letter! Who will you write to? What would you like to persuade them to do? Some ideas could be: persuade your parents to let you join a new club, persuade your teacher to allow you to have extra break time, persuade your favourite footballer to come into school, etc.

Daily reading

Read at least 1 book from the 6 book challenge and complete a book review.

Science

We have been learning about the states of matter – solids, liquids, gases. Can you investigate this further at home? **Ideas:**

- Sort things in your home into solids, liquids and gases. Make a table in your book with your results, use drawings, photos or words.
- Get cooking – use a recipe and label the different processes that take place (e.g. chocolate melting and cooling to make rice Krispie cakes)
- Place ice in a bag and observe it melting over time, how long does it take, try different temperatures.

Art

In art we have explored animated drawings, can you make your own at home? You could draw a family member and use strips for different eyes and mouths, make a puppet that can move against a background, make your own flip book to bring your drawings to life or try a split pin version of your favourite character.

PSHCE

Create an anti-bullying poster which we can display in our classrooms. Think about how you can make this bold and eye-catching, yet still informative.

Geography

Draw a map of the route you would take from your house to Morrisons. Make sure to include street names and any key features that you would pass on the way (e.g. lakes, trees, parks, places of worship).

DT

In DT (sewing), we are designing, creating and evaluating our own Christmas stockings. Using old material you have around your house, design and make your own decoration for a festival you celebrate. Use 2 different types of stitch (blanket and running) and evaluate your final product once you have finished.
