Next week we will be sending out more information about our Arbor platform including—setting up your account. We aim to have everyone set up over the next 2 weeks!

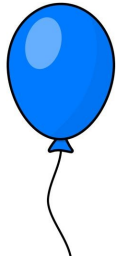
